All accepted **full conference papers** will be published in Springer series CCIS (Communications in Computer and Information Science). Best papers, as further developed versions, will be published also in a special Issue of International Journal of Telemedicine and Clinical Practices. The full papers are expected to be 4000 - 5000 words long.

All accepted **abstracts** with a presentation will be published in Turku Center for Computer Science General Publication series. An abstract are expected to be maximum 500 words long.
