About

It welcomes diverse contributions offering empirical, theoretical and historical perspectives. The 11th conference in the series will be organized by the Department of Archivistics, Library and Information Science at Oslo Metropolitan University, and will take place from May 29 – June 1, 2022.

Conference themes

The theme of the conference is - as indicated in the name CoLIS - Conceptions (approaches, theories, etc.) of Library and Information Science (LIS). This concerns the well-established LIS subfields, such as:

- Library studies
- Practices of literary and cultural dissemination
- The social values of reading and literature
- Information architecture
- Information behavior and practices
- Information literacy and related literacies
- Interactive information retrieval
- Information systems
- Scholarly communication
- Bibliometrics, scientometrics, webometrics
- Interaction design and user experience
- Archival studies
- History and philosophy of information

We welcome submissions on all aspects of the subject, including information science, information systems, library science, archives, records management, and digital humanities.
